SUPERVISORS MEETING **February 22, 2017**

A public meeting of the Providence Township Board of Supervisors was held in the Township Municipal Office on Wednesday, February 22, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. Present were Chairman David Gerhart, Vice Chairman C. William Shaffer, Member John Schroeder, Manager Vicki Eldridge, Zoning Officer Constance Peiffer and twelve (12) observers.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Gerhart at 7:00 P.M followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Mr. Gerhart offered prayer.

BID AWARD

- Following a brief discussion, Mr. Gerhart made a motion, seconded by Mr. Shaffer to award the bid for the construction of a pedestrian bridge over Route 222 as part of the Enola Low Grade Trail to Kinsley Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$1,916,758.00. The motion was carried unanimously. Kinsley was the lowest bidder.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Discussions began regarding the permitting and rebuilding process following a disaster such as a fire. Mrs. Peiffer and Pete Kingsley (Commonwealth Code Inspector) shared information that is contained in the UCC building code relating to rebuilding following a disaster.
