## **BUDGET WORKSHOP** **September 25, 2017**

The Providence Township Board of Supervisors held a budget workshop in the Township Municipal Office on Monday, September 25, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. Present were Chairman David Gerhart, Vice Chairman C. William Shaffer, Member John Schroeder, Manager Vicki Eldridge and one (1) observer.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Gerhart at 7:00 p.m.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Mrs. Eldridge reviewed the employee health insurance renewal with the supervisors. Following a lengthy discussion, Mr. Gerhart made a motion, seconded by Mr. Shaffer to renew the current employee health insurance plan with no additional cost to the employees. Mr. Schroeder would like to see a portion of the premium increase be borne by the employees. The motion passed with two favorable votes. Mr. Schroeder opposed the motion.
- Following discussions regarding the dust issues associated with the boiler, Mrs. Eldridge was directed to have the roadmaster acquire additional quotes for the installation of a dust collection system.
- Following a brief discussion regarding stormwater issues along Mt. Hope School Road, Mrs. Eldridge was directed to have the township engineer along with the road master visit the site to see what, if anything, could help the situation.
- At this time the proposed revenues for 2018 were discussed.
- Mr. Shaffer asked that each one of us look for opportunities to have a governmental agency rent the front office in the township building once the Kinsley lease expires. This would provide a great public service as well as additional income to the township.
- Mr. Shaffer suggested the roadmaster schedule an LTAP course here in the township about Winter Maintenance.
- Mr. Schroeder, a representative to the Quarryville Fire Company Safety Committee, encouraged each supervisor to take time to visit the new addition to the fire house.

**ADJOURNMENT:**

- With no further business, Mr. Gerhart made a motion, seconded by Mr. Schroeder, to adjourn the meeting at 8:40 p.m. The motion was carried unanimously.
