ZONING WORKSHOP June 25, 2018

The zoning workshop of the Providence Township Board of Supervisors was held in the Township Municipal Office on Monday, June 25, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. Present were Chairman John Schroeder, Vice Chairman C. William Shaffer, Member J. Pepper Goslin, Solicitor Melvin Newcomer, Zoning Officer Heidi Martinez, Township Engineer Mark Deimler and eighteen (18) observers.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Schroeder at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Following a brief discussion regarding the contribution increase request from Rawlinsville Fire Company, Mr. Schroeder made a motion, seconded by Mr. Goslin to increase the contribution amount to \$15,000 starting in 2019 and continuing for a total of five (5) years. The motion was carried unanimously.
- Following a brief discussion regarding Cornerstone Retreat, 585 Pennsy Road, it was determined that the letter submitted by Christ Beiler was sufficient confirmation that all operations have ceased at this location.
- Discussion resumed regarding the zoning ordinance update. Primary discussion involved the direction the Board of Supervisors would like to pursue in regards to zoning. After discussion it was determined that the zoning ordinance review focus on three main points; simplification, readability and less restrictiveness. The recommendation was made for the Planning Commission to review the zoning ordinance for the next two (2) or three (3) meetings by section and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors. The next zoning workshop on July 23, 2018 will continue to work on the minor items presented at the initial zoning workshop.
