ZONING WORKSHOP August 24, 2020

The Providence Township Board of Supervisors held a zoning workshop in the township municipal office on Monday, August 24, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. Present were Chairman John Schroeder, Vice Chairman J. Pepper Goslin, Member Lori Crossen, Manager Vicki Eldridge, Zoning Officer Heidi Martinez, Township Engineer Mark Deimler and no observers.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Schroeder at 7:00 P.M followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

OLD BUSINESS

Following a discussion regarding the sale of the CAT Front End Loader, Mr. Schroeder made a motion, seconded by Mr. Goslin to authorize Municibid to award the bid to the second highest bidder. The motion was carried unanimously.

Following a discussion regarding the paint failure on the pedestrian bridge, Mrs. Crossen stated that she and the township manager attended a meeting regarding the repairs to the bridge on Thursday, August 20, 2020. Mr. Schroeder asked for copies of the repair procedures from the contractor. He also asked for the specifications used for the adhesion testing. He asked that two adhesion tests be performed in different areas.

ZONING BUSINESS

- Mr. Goslin stated he would like to see some changes in the agricultural zoning and commercial zoning regulations to make them more user-friendly.
