BUDGET WORKSHOP **October 7, 2020**

The Providence Township Board of Supervisors held a budget workshop in the township municipal office on Wednesday, September 30, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. Present were Chairman John Schroeder, Vice Chairman J. Pepper Goslin, Member Lori Crossen, Manager Vicki Eldridge and one (1) observer.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Schroeder at 7:00 P.M followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

At this time, Roadmaster Jim Fry presented the 2021 Road Budget. Highlights of the road budget are as follows:

- Asphalt leveling projects on Scheller Road, Fairview Road (Truce to Cinder), Sawmill Road (Scheller to Pennsy) and Shenks Wood Court.
- Seal coating on Archery Road, Evans Drive, Oak Bottom Road, Frogtown Road, Kreider Road and Herr Road.
- General pipe repair projects on Sawmill Road and Pennsy Road.

Following discussions regarding the purchase of a new pickup truck for the road crew, the supervisors agreed to purchase a used vehicle (Value not to exceed \$7,000) for the office staff to use. This will allow the Ford F150 pickup to be used by the road crew, especially during mowing season.

The supervisors agreed to review revenues in the first quarter of 2021 and review additional purchase requests for small equipment, truck repairs and painting the snow plows.

The use of salt brine was discussed and the supervisors directed the roadmaster to contact municipalities' that have the equipment to see if we could borrow it to have a trial run this winter.

- With no further business, Mr. Schroeder made a motion, seconded by Mr. Goslin, to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 p.m. The motion was carried unanimously.
