ZONING WORKSHOP **October 28, 2024**

The Providence Township Board of Supervisors held a zoning workshop in the township municipal office on Monday, October 28, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. Present were Chairman Lori Crossen, Vice Chairman J. Pepper Goslin, Member John Schroeder, Township Zoning Officer Ben McCue, and Township Manager Vicki Eldridge.
