Parks and Recreation Committee Meeting April 9, 2026 7:00 p.m.

The regular meeting of the Providence Township Parks and Recreation Committee Meeting was held in the township municipal office on Thursday, April 9, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. Those present were Township Manager Vicki Eldridge, Committee Members, Brian Longenecker, Marla Davis, Lori Walter, Warren Walter, Bob Kaschak, Sean Smith, Frank Voyner, Bill Musser and Becky Guhl.

The Township Manager opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m. Mrs. Eldridge gave an update on the trail corridor from Manor Township to Sadsbury Township.

Mrs. Eldridge shared that the park bench in honor of Roy Snyder should be installed this spring/summer as time allows. The bench has been built by the road crew.

Sean Smith gave an update on the Mountain Bike Park. He also shared a map that he and the County GIS Department have designed showing the mountain bike park trail system.

Bill Musser asked to have some stone dust delivered to Sigman Road Trailhead. There is a washed-out area at the Sigman Road Bridge that needs to be filled. Mrs. Eldridge will speak to the roadmaster about this issue.

Several members mentioned the issue of dog waste. At the Fairview 1 trailhead, people are gathering the waste, however they pile the bags at the trailhead. The members asked if there are plans to add a dog waste station on the trail. Mrs. Eldridge said the trail has always been a carry-in/carry-out venue. We did not want to have trash receptacles that need to be maintained since it would add additional duties to our road crew.

Sean Smith asked if a small tool shed could be placed in the mountain bike park. There are a lot of young people that ride bikes to the park and would be willing to rake and maintain the trails; however, they can't bring the tools on their bikes. Mrs. Eldridge will make this request known to the supervisors.

With no other business to transact, the meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
